Early detection of breast cancer by Low Radiation 3D Mammography improves the chances that breast cancer can be diagnosed at an early state and treated successfully, hopefully without chemotherapy.

Breast Tomosynthesis or 3D Mammography is breakthrough technology that allows the radiologist to view the breast tissue with much greater clarity. InHealth Imaging has added a low radiation component to its 3D technology, called C-View, which means that now our 3D radiation levels are lower than conventional mammography.

3D Mammography reduces anxiety and the need for call-backs. In addition, patients report that Low Radiation 3D Mammography is more comfortable than standard 2D digital mammograms.

During the examination, an x-ray arm sweeps in a slight arc over the breast, as it takes multiple breast images in just seconds. A computer produces a 3D image of the breast tissue in one millimeter layers or "slices." Fine details are more visible, no longer hidden by tissue above and below.
